- 1. If you spent one day as a King or Queen, what do you think life would like? What would you do? What would be done for you? What would you enjoy most about being royalty?
- 2. If you spent one say as a servant to the King or Queen, what do you think that would be like? What would you do? Would you enjoy this?

DIG DEEPER

Read Philippians 2:5 in the International Children's Bible Translation below.

"In your lives you must think and act like Christ Jesus."

1. One of God's greatest purposes for our lives it to become like Jesus. How does Jesus think and act in a different way than royalty you've read about throughout history (or even other kings in the Bible)? Look up Mark 10:45.

Read & Reflect on Philippians 2:6 below.

"Christ himself was like God in everything. He was equal with God. But he did not think that being equal with God was something to be held on to."

2. Who is Christ equal to? What does this passage say about who Christ is? Look up John 1:1-3 & Colossians 1:16

Our triune God has always existed. God the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit were never created and have always been. Out of God's overflowing love He created humanity, who soon rebelled against God and His authority and chose to live their own way which brought devastating consequences. Jesus, the Son was sent on a rescue mission to save us and was sent from the glories of Heaven, where He had been worshipped by angels, to the humble realities of life on this earth. This is explained in verses 7 & 8.

Read & Reflect on Philippians 2:7-8 below.

"He gave up his place with God and made himself nothing. He was born as a man and became like a servant. And when he was living as a man, he humbled himself and was fully obedient to God. He obeyed even when that caused his death—death on a cross."

- 3. What do you think it would be like to leave the glories of Heaven to come down to this earth where people did not know that He was the Creator and the King?
- 4. Jesus is fully God and He also became fully man. He is the only person who ever lived who is 100% God and 100% man! Look below to see how Jesus displayed humility in His life. How did He lower Himself?



Matthew 23:12 says that whoever humbles themselves will be exalted. Read the next verses.

Read & reflect on Philippians 2:9-11 below.

"So God raised Christ to the highest place. God made the name of Christ greater than every other name. God wants every knee to bow to Jesus— everyone in heaven, on earth, and under the earth. One day everyone will say, "Jesus Christ is Lord" and bring glory to God the Father."




