1. What do you think you need in life to be happy? Do you think it's possible to be joyful even in difficult circumstances?

What does it look like to store our treasures in heaven? Is there anything that you can give away to someone in need? A toy? A game?

DIG DEEPER

Today, we are going to wrap up our study in Philippians talking about Christian contentment. Contentment is a fancy word that means to be satisfied in Christ. As Christians, we can have a relationship with the Lord that satisfies our souls. Paul learned this precious truth and wants us to know it too. As we know the Lord, we will increasingly let go of the things of this world that cannot satisfy and invest our treasures in heaven.

Read Philippians 4:10-11 below. Underline words, phrases or verses that stand out to you.

10 I am very happy in the Lord that you have shown your care for me again. You continued to care about me, but there was no way for you to show it. 11 I am telling you this, but it is not because I need anything. I have learned to be satisfied with the things I have and with everything that happens.

3. Paul states that he rejoices in the Lord for the Philippians monetary gift, but not because he needed anything. He says in verse 11 that he has "________ to be satisfied with the things he has and with everything that happens". What does it look like for you to be satisfied with what you have and to be grateful no matter what happens?


Read Philippians 4:12. Underline words, phrases or verses that stand out to you.
