Discussion Questions Psalm 58

What stood out to you in the podcast and/or in the reading of this Psalm?

David is wrestling with injustice among leaders in Israel. Have you ever wrestled with frustration or anger when injustice prevailed? What lessons can we learn from this Psalm about what to do with these feelings?

What does this Psalm teach us about God? Humanity? What does it teach us about how depraved humanity can get if they give themselves over to evil?

What does David pray for the wicked? Which image surprises you? Why would it be wrong to pray these curses for our personal enemies? Is it okay for Christians to pray these prayers? If so, when & how?

What is the promise in vv. 10-11 for those who have been declared righteous by faith in Christ?

What truths in this Psalm encourage your heart? Which truths challenge you?
