Psalm 73



What stood out to you in the teaching and/or in the reading of this Psalm?

Asaph knows that God is good toward His people, but he struggles to believe that God is good toward him personally. Have you ever wrestled with this before?



Who is Asaph envious of? Why is he struggling with envy? Have you struggled with this vice before? What is at the root of envy?



What shift takes place in verse 17 that helped Asaph see clearly? What truths did he need to remember?



What truths from vv 23-26 are most precious to you?



How can we come to a place to say with the Psalmist, "there is nothing on earth I desire besides you?" What are other desires that compete for our affections?



What truths in this Psalm encourage your heart? Which truths challenge you?
